**Project Description**

Lannigan Field, home to the University's track and field programs, is in need of significant improvements. It is currently one of only two athletics venues on Grounds that rely on temporary restroom facilities. The proposed conditioned support building will provide eighteen dedicated restrooms for varsity athletics and eighteen additional restrooms for spectators. The project also includes expanded track storage, utility and janitorial support areas, and a new water bottle filler located near the venue entrance. These enhancements will allow for the complete removal of portable toilets for both daily training and competitive events.

The proposed building is a 3,000 GSF, single-story concrete masonry unit structure with a flat roof and a navy-blue painted exterior. Rooftop HVAC equipment will be fully screened by a metal enclosure. A UVA Athletics logo will be mounted on the CMU wall facing Copeley Road to reinforce program identity.

### **Architectural Aesthetic**

The Lannigan Field support building is designed as a functional, utilitarian facility that provides permanent restroom capacity at this important track and field training and competition venue. It is envisioned as an early phase of a future stadium seating project that would ultimately clad the exterior in UVA's contextual red brick, aligning the building's architectural character with nearby Disharoon Park (Baseball), Klockner Stadium (Soccer and Lacrosse), and Palmer Park (Softball).

### **Relationship to Approved Master Plan**

The proposed improvements are consistent with the Athletics Master Plan completed in 2018 and the Athletics Stadium Study completed in 2025, which assessed facility needs at Klockner Stadium, the Track and Field complex, and the Field Hockey venue.

### **Existing Architectural Context**

Lannigan Field has served as the home of UVA's Varsity Track & Field and Cross Country programs since 1971 and is recognized for its best-in-class competition surfaces. The venue sits within a larger "Park of Parks," with Disharoon Park to the northwest, Klockner Stadium to the north, and Palmer Park to the northeast. It remains one of only two competition venues lacking permanent restrooms for athletes and spectators. Because the track is open to the public each morning, the new restrooms will also be available for community use. A surface parking lot is located immediately to the east, and to the south are Coogan Way and the adjacent railway corridor.














