DGS to enforce Governor Street restrictions, control access to 11th, Old 14th streets

~ Employees must show ID to gain access ~

RICHMOND, VA – The Department of General Services will be monitoring traffic on Governor Street to ensure authorized vehicles are using the street as posted on traffic signs along Broad Street. Authorized vehicles are those operated by state employees and emergency responders.

Signs designating Governor Street for “Authorized Vehicles” have been in place for some time. Beginning Feb. 3, DGS will work with the Division of Capitol Police and DGS’ contract security to ensure only authorized vehicles are turning onto Governor Street. DGS also will control traffic on 11th and Old 14th streets to ensure only those who are authorized to park in DGS-maintained parking areas are allowed access.

Individuals turning onto Governor, 11th and Old 14th streets will be required to show their state employee identification to gain access

As a reminder, parking in state-controlled parking spaces in and around Capitol Square is limited to those individuals in the DGS-managed parking system. Any media who wish to park near Capitol Square should contact Dena Potter at dena.potter@dgs.virginia.gov for guidance.
